## NRC to Hold Public Meeting of the Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes

**ROCKVILLE, Md.** — The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission’s Advisory Committee on the Medical Uses of Isotopes will [meet](#) April 20-21, to discuss a range of topics related to the medical use of radioactive materials. The meetings are open to the public, except for portions that may be closed to protect personal privacy or pre-decisional information, as permitted under the Freedom of Information Act.

**What:** The ACMUI will review medical events, discuss subcommittee recommendations on the Advance Act mission statement, consider proposed guidance on licensing alpha-emitting radiopharmaceutical therapies, review potential artificial intelligence and deep-learning applications in the NRC’s medical oversight, and receive updates from the NRC’s Medical Radiation Safety Team.

**When:** Monday, April 20, 9:00 am Eastern time; Tuesday, April 21, 10:00 a.m.–1:30 p.m. Eastern time. On April 21, the ACMUI will also brief the Commission during a [public meeting](#).
