## NRC to Hold Regulatory Conference on Safety Issue at Surry Nuclear Plant

ATLANTA, Ga.— Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will hold a [regulatory conference](#) with Dominion Energy to discuss a preliminary safety finding at the Surry nuclear power plant in Surry, Virginia.

The apparent [violation](#) involves the company's failure to provide adequate written procedures for maintenance on a turbine-driven auxiliary feedwater pump, a system important to plant safety. The NRC has preliminarily categorized the finding as "White," which indicates low safety significance but does result in increased NRC oversight.

The meeting will allow Dominion Energy to present its perspective and provide additional information before the NRC makes a final determination. No decisions on the final safety significance or any potential NRC actions will be made at the meeting.
