NRC to Hold Hybrid Public Meeting on Part 53

ROCKVILLE, Md. – The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold a [public meeting](#) on the 10 CFR Part 53 final rule, “Risk-Informed, Technology-Inclusive Regulatory Framework for Commercial Nuclear Plants,” published March 30. The rule became effective on April 29.

What: Hybrid public meeting for the NRC staff to provide a general introduction and overview of the final rule and related implementation activities, and respond to participant questions.

When: Monday, May 18, 1:00-2:30 pm Eastern time

Where: Commission Hearing Room, One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville Maryland

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission was created as an expert, technical agency to protect public health, safety, and security, and regulate the civilian use of nuclear materials, including enabling the deployment of nuclear power for the benefit of society. Among other responsibilities, the agency issues licenses, conducts inspections, initiates and enforces regulations, and plans for incident response. The NRC is collaborating with interagency partners to implement reforms outlined in new Executive Orders and the ADVANCE Act to streamline agency activities and enhance efficiency.
