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NRC to Host 7th Artificial Intelligence Workshop

ROCKVILLE, Md. — The NRC will host its seventh [Artificial Intelligence Workshop](#), "Navigating the AI Landscape: Regulator Transformation, Industry Innovation, and Global Collaboration," on Sept. 15.

Who: NRC staff, licensees, industry stakeholders, academia, research organizations and the public.

What: Providing updates on NRC's AI maturity and regulatory readiness, demonstrations of internal AI use cases, and discussions on industry innovation and regulatory considerations for safe AI deployment. Agenda includes opening remarks from NRC Chief Artificial Intelligence Officer Caroline Carusone, presentations, flash talks, and open discussion.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission was created as an expert, technical agency to protect public health, safety, and security, and regulate the civilian use of nuclear materials, including enabling the deployment of nuclear power for the benefit of society. Among other responsibilities, the agency issues licenses, conducts inspections, initiates and enforces regulations, and plans for incident response. The NRC is collaborating with interagency partners to implement reforms outlined in new Executive Orders and the ADVANCE Act to streamline agency activities and enhance efficiency.
