Jessica Bielecki



Ms. Bielecki currently serves as Chief of Staff to Chairman Ho K. Nieh, bringing almost two decades of regulatory and leadership experience to the role. Ms. Bielecki joined the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in 2007 as an Honor Law Graduate in the Office of the General Counsel (OGC), supporting operating and new reactor licensing. In 2012, she was detailed as legal counsel for an NRC Commissioner. Upon returning to OGC in 2013, Ms. Bielecki served as Deputy Assistant General Counsel for the High-Level Waste, Fuel Cycle, and Nuclear Security Division, and as lead attorney for the Yucca Mountain proceeding.

Throughout her career, Ms. Bielecki has held a variety of leadership positions across the agency, including roles in the Offices of the Chief Financial Officer, Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and Executive Director for Operations, as well as Acting Assistant General Counsel and Acting Deputy General Counsel in OGC. Most recently, she served as an advisor to the NRC's ADVANCE Act Core Team and as Assistant General Counsel for the Rulemaking, Agreement States, and Fee Policy Division, OGC, leading regulatory reform efforts in response to Executive Order 14300.

Ms. Bielecki earned a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science and a Juris Doctor, and is a graduate of the NRC's Senior Executive Service Candidate Development Program.
