Mr. Cuadrado currently serves as Technical Assistant for Materials to Chairman Ho K. Nieh. He joined the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission in 2002 and has since built a notable career in nuclear materials safety and policy. Over the years, he has held leadership roles in licensing reviews and policy development for spent fuel storage, radioactive materials transportation, and high-level waste disposal within the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards (NMSS).

His experience includes positions of increasing responsibility, such as Project Engineer in the Spent Fuel Project Office and Project Manager in both the Division of High-Level Waste Repository Safety and the Division of Fuel Management within NMSS. He later served as Chief of the Materials Security Branch in the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response. In 2023, Mr. Cuadrado completed a detail as Congressional Affairs Officer, and in 2025, he served as Deputy Associate Director in NRC's Office of Congressional Affairs.

Mr. Cuadrado holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Chemical Engineering and a Master of Business Administration degree in Finance.
